**6. Habitat Area**

- Nature trail created with insect hotel, log piles and interpretation boards to boost biodiversity and educational value
- Existing mature trees managed to create 'Woodland Glade' habitat along route of former River Westbourne

**3. Play Improvements and 'Pop-Up' Cafe**

- Opportunities for combined play facility with mix of equipment for all ages
- Millennium Garden reinterpreted as a cafe/picnic area with performance space.
- Improved planting scheme and increased tree planting.
- Power and water point provided for pop-up cafe.
- Existing nature trail improved.
- Improved link to Play Hut.
- Opportunity to move attendants hut to improve connectivity between play hut and renewed play area, and improve monitoring of the park.

**4. Play Hut & Play/Youth Activity Space**

- Adventure play has reached the end of natural life. The main climbing structures have begun to rot and need removing.
- Investigate options for renewing and widening appeal of Play/Youth Activity Space. Proposals to be developed with the local community.
- Potential for play terrace to be increased in size.

**5. Flower Garden**

- Existing Rose Garden restored to create a feature site.
- Surrounding rose beds renewed with sustainable planting to increase biodiversity and reduce maintenance
- Tree planting thinned to increase sunlight
- Resurfacing treatments
- Seating enclaves with games tables.

**1. Kilburn Plaza/ High Road Entrance**

- High quality paved community activity/events space
- Tree planting to form Plaza
- Improved vehicle access to central events space
- Full width ornamental sliding gate
- Park fence line moved to allow evening events and MUGA access
- Lighting to allow evening events
- MUGA resurfacing
- Proposed kick-wall or basketball pad to side of MUGA
- Park attendants hut relocated to park fence line
- Potential toilet access to existing changing facility when MUGA is not in use (dependant on acceptable operational model)

**2. Grangeway Entrance**

- Entrance improvements to gates and surface treatments
- Footpath widened to provide visual link to Play Hut
- Selective tree removals and plant thinning to open vista
- Refurbishment of existing tennis courts
- Table tennis tables next to tennis courts
- Improved lighting
