

Free 2 year old places Camden's application process

When to apply

Please apply when your child is 18 months old. You can look for a nursery or childminder (who is part of the scheme) at this time.

If successful your child becomes eligible for a place;

A child born on or between 1 April and 31 August will become eligible for a place from 1 September following their second birthday.

A child born on or between 1 September and 31 December will become eligible for a place from 1 January following their second birthday.

A child born on or between 1 January and 31 March will become eligible for a place from 1 April following their second birthday.

After applying

Once your application has been assessed, you will receive an email or a letter with the outcome of your application. If eligible, you will also receive a list of childcare providers.

This process can take up to 4 weeks.

To secure a childcare placement please show the email on your phone or take a copy of the email or your eligibility letter and a copy of your child's birth certificate or passport to the chosen nursery or childminder.
