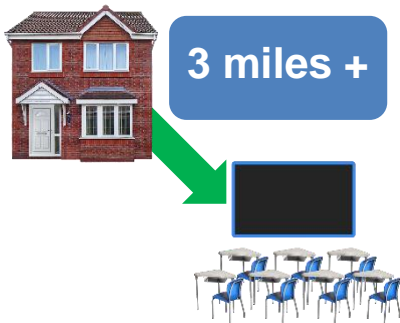
This policy explains how we can support children and young people with **SEND** to get to school or college up to the age of 25

SEND stands for Special Educational Needs and Disability



You must be **eligible** to get help

If you are **eligible** for a service, this means you have the right to receive that service because of your circumstances



If you are at school **up to year 11**, you will be eligible if

- you live more than 3 miles away from your nearest school

or



- your needs are so complicated that you cannot get to school even with help from your parents/carers

16-17



If you are at college and **aged 16–17**, you will be eligible if

- you are in full time education (**15 hours or more per week**)

and

- your needs are so complicated that we have to make a special arrangement for you

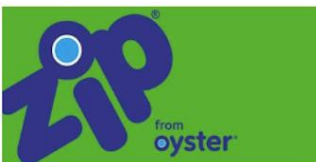


18+



If you are at college and **aged 18 or over**, you will be assessed under the **Care Act**

Other help



- Free and discounted travel from TFL for young people **aged 5-17**



- A Freedom pass for **18-25 year olds**



- The option of a **Personal Transport Budget**



- Direct transport provided in special circumstances



- Independent travel training

Escorts

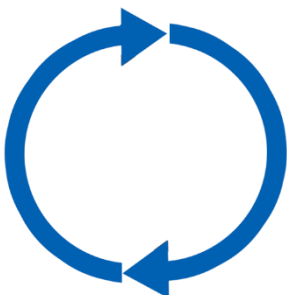


We will decide if you need to have an escort to support you when travelling

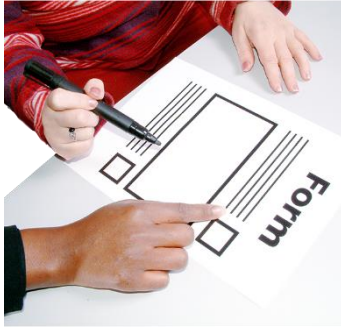


Changes to arrangements
